

Welcome to Autumn 2 in Year 1

Here is a brief summary of what will we be learning this term.

In **Writing**, we will be learning how to write instructions on How to Catch a Star based on our model text of How to catch a Fairy. We will be exploring adjectives and verbs.

In **Spelling**, we will be spelling the everyday words we know independently in our writing.

In **Handwriting**, we will be continuing to present our work neatly and correctly form our letters

As **Geographers** we will learn about where we live and understand that Northampton is in England, which is a country in the United Kingdom. We will study our local area in more detail, with a focus on transport, services and different types of houses. We will develop an understanding of our own school grounds and will use mapping skills to secure our learning.

PE, we will be following our Real PE curriculum. We will be looking at Social skills involved in exercise, including working sensibly, taking turns and sharing.

In **Phonics**- We will be consolidating the different spellings for the sounds /ae/ and /ee/ sounds and then move on through the extended code. In every lesson, we will be blending and segmenting as well as looking at polysyllabic words.

DT – we will be making smoothies. We will be exploring different fruits and practising skills such as peeling, cutting and blending.

As **Musicians**, we will be developing a sense of beat. We will be exploring different ways that music can be used to describe the weather.

As **Mathematicians**, we will be continuing to look at numbers between 0 and 100. We will be looking at different patterns and counting in lots of different ways, such as counting in 10s and counting in 1s across the 10s e.g. 29, 30, 31.

In Mastering Number, we will be looking at numbers 5 – 10. We are using sentence stems such as '5 needs 2 to make 7' and '8 is made of 5 and 3, 5 and 3 make 8'

Computing –we will be finding out about the technology in our classrooms and how to use a computer responsibly.

PSHCE, we will be finding out about the best learning behaviours, making good choices and ways to cope with sadness..

RE - we will learn what many Christians think God is like. We will explore how Christians learn about God, what stories in the Bible say about God and why God is important to Christians.

As **Scientists**, we will learn the names of the body parts. We will explore which part of the body is associated with each sense with a focus on the sense of smell and hearing. We will use all of our senses to describe an object.
