

Welcome to Spring 1 in Year 1

Here is a brief summary of what will we be learning this term

In **Writing**, we will be learning the journey tale, *Handa's Surprise*.

We will be focusing on building secure sentence structures and describing characters and objects using adjectives to describe the senses and personalities.

In Phonics we will consolidate our understanding of the extended code and continue to develop our knowledge.

In handwriting, we will be continuing to present our work neatly and correctly form our letters.

Our reading unit will be based on the book *The Boy, His Dog and the Sea* by Anthony Browne.

As mathematicians, we will be looking at the composition of numbers including partitioning. We will be solving calculation problems using simple addition and subtraction including missing numbers. We will also be looking at 2D shapes.

As scientists, we will be identifying and naming materials. We will explore the difference between an object and the material from which it is made. In addition, we will be learning about the season of 'Winter'.

As historians, we will be learning about Mary Seacole and Edith Cavell and the legacy they left behind.

The children will learn about these 2 significant individuals from the past and know how their achievements have influenced life today.

As artists, we will be creating seascapes using powder paints. The children will learn how to independently organise their own equipment for painting, and they will investigate colour by mixing small quantities and varying pigments to change shade and tone.

In computing, we will be learning how to write using the keyboard. The children will learn to edit their work.

In e-safety, we will be learning about online reputation and take part in Safer Internet Day.


In PE, we will be following our PE Real PE curriculum. The children will develop and apply their dynamic balance on a line and stance through focused skill development sessions, thematic stories and games.
