Welcome to Autumn 2 in Year 1 Here is a brief summary of what will we be learning this term.

In Writing, we will be learning how to write a set of instructions. We will be looking at 'imperative' verbs eg put, make, stir, add. We also will learn these as 'bossy' verbs. We will be looking at the main features of Instructional Texts. In **Spelling**, we will be spelling the everyday words we know independently in our writing.

In **Phonics**- We will be consolidating the different spellings for the sounds /ae/ and /ee/ sounds and then move on through the extended code.

In **Handwriting**, we will be continuing to present our work neatly and correctly form our letters

In **Reading**, we will be exploring the picture book Rosies Walk by Pat Hutchins. We will be using evidence from the text, both stated and implied, to make predictions about the story. We will use the stem sentences I predict that.... I think that...

As Mathematicians, we will be adding and subtracting within 10. We will also be identifying 2d and 3d shapes and their properties.

In Number Sense we will be making and breaking numbers 2-10.

Our KIRFs (Key Instant Recall Facts) are reading and writing numbers to 50.

As **Scientists**, we will learn the names of the body parts. We will explore which part of the body is associated with each sense with a focus on the sense of smell and hearing. We will use all of our senses to describe an object.

As Historians we will learn the facts around the Gunpowder plot and the significance of the bonfire.

As **Geographers** we will learn about where we live and understand that Northampton is in England, which is a country in the United Kingdom. We will study our local area in more detail, with a focus on transport, services and different types of houses. We will develop an

understanding of our own school grounds and will use mapping skills to secure our learning.

DT – We will be making and evaluating a food product based on our own design. We will be thinking about healthy eating and making the right choices.

Computing –we will be finding out about the technology in our classrooms and how to use a computer responsibly.

In PSHCE, we will be celebrating differences. **RE**, we will learn the main aspects of the Christmas story. We will find out about the people involved and why Christians give gifts at Christmas. We will find out who gave gifts and messages in the Christmas story and make the connections between the meaning behind gifts given at Christmas and their own experience of giving and receiving gifts.
