

Welcome to Spring 1 in Year 2

Here is a brief summary of what will we be learning this term?

As writers, we will be focusing on persuasive writing, using the model text 'Cosy Cottage.'

In grammar, we will be learning about superlatives – adding the 'est' suffix.

In spelling, we are focusing on the common exception words for Year Two and the use of the possessive apostrophe.

In handwriting, we are reviewing all the Kinetic Letter families through sentence work.

In reading, we will be focusing on the book Aristotle and our Big Investigative Question is 'Who is Bella Donna?'

As mathematicians, we will be developing our multiplication and division knowledge. We will also be learning about money: making amounts and calculating the amount of change needed.

As scientists, we will be learning about food chains and why they are important. We will also be finding out about habitats and how the food chains differ in each habitat.

As Historians we are learning about why Christopher Columbus and Neil Armstrong are remembered as great explorers.

As musicians, we will be learning music through the topic of space. We will be developing the musical elements of dynamics, timbre, tempo and motifs.

In computing, we will be using a computer to create music. We will compare creating music digitally and non-digitally.

In RE, we will be learning how Muslims show their commitment to Allah.

In PSHCE, we will be learning about dreams and goals for our lives in the year ahead.
