As writers, we will be focusing on writing stories with action, based upon Supertato.

In grammar, we will be learning about using different conjunctions for effect.

In spelling, we are focusing on using aa range of suffixes and prefixes.

In reading, we will be focusing on defeat the monster poems. We will study the language choices used to build the picture.

As mathematicians, we will be focusing on identifying and finding fractions of shapes and amounts. We will also be learning to tell the time to the hour, half hour, quarter hour and 5 minutes. This term we will also be focusing on solving problems using a range of calculations.

In PSHCE, we will be learning about building positive, healthy relationships.


In Art, we will be learning to mix shades of green and brown to create a painting inspired by Flora in the locality.


For our fundamental movement skills, we will be sending and receiving.
