

Welcome to Spring 1 in Year 3

Here is a brief summary of what will we be learning this term?

As writers, we will be learning to write portal stories that take the character back in time with a focus on describing settings and objects. We will be focusing on using effective language, including adjectives and fronted adverbials in our grammar learning. In spelling we are focusing on polysyllabic words, year 3 and 4 common exception words and common homophones (e.g. there, their and they're). In handwriting we will continue to learn the letter joins with an increase in flow and fluency.

In reading we will be exploring an extract from Charlotte's Web that focuses on describing a setting. Our big investigative questions are: What is the barn like? and How do you know? We will be finding evidence from the text to answer these.

As mathematicians we will be learning to multiply and divide 2-digit numbers by a one digit number. Later in the term, we will be looking at measuring using length and perimeter.

As scientists we will be investigating and learning all about different rocks, soils and fossils and how they are formed.

In RE, we are focusing on the Hindu Religion. We will answer the overarching question: What do the different deities represent to Hindus?

As artists, we are developing our painting skills, learning to vary the colours and textures in a landscape to create mood and feeling. Our artist appreciation unit focuses on the work of David Hockney.

In computing, we will be animating, making simple animations linked to our history topic.

In PSHE, our theme is dreams and goals. We will be understanding how to cooperate with others and that working collaboratively can help me. To recognise to persevere when we find things difficult.

In French, we are learning about instruments and learning to say and write a simple phrase.

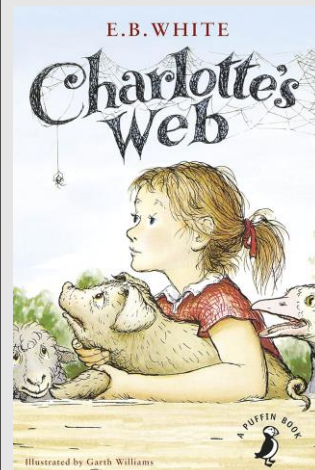
As historians, we are learning about the Romans, focusing on the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain.
