Here is a brief summary of what will we be learning this term

As writers, we will be learning about the features of persuasive writing, with a focus on hooking the reader in and choosing the vocabulary we will need to persuade someone to visit a specific place.

In grammar, we will be recapping fronted adverbials and learning about superlatives and clauses in the middle of sentences which add more information.

In spelling, we will be talking about syllables and how they can help us to spell words from the Year 3 and 4 expected word list.

In handwriting, we will continue to strengthen our knowledge of letter families to support with our joining.

As readers, we will be exploring the amazing book 'The Wonder Garden' and discussing why we would want to visit The Amazon Rainforest, using the text to support our reasoning.

As mathematicians, we will be consolidating our knowledge of place value, and addition and subtraction and will move onto multiplication and division.

As scientists, we will be investigating and learning all about the digestive systems and food chains.

As Geographers, we will be thinking about why the rainforests of the world are important to us. The rainforest explorer will be visiting on **1.11.23** to start this topic with a bang!

As designers, we will be learning about British inventors and we will have a go at making some of our own.

In computing, we will be learning how to use the coding programme Scratch.

In PSICHE, we will be using the Jigsaw programme to celebrate differences and learn about self-esteem. We will also be thinking about Remembrance Day.

In French, the children will be learning some names of animals and asking and answering questions about them in French.

In RE, the children will be thinking about why Diwali and Christmas are important festivals.
