Welcome to Autumn 2 in Year 5 Here is a brief summary of what will we be learning this term

As writers, we will be learning about persuasive writing. Our model text will be a speech written from the perspective of Rosa Parks.

In grammar, we will be learning through grammar games. In spelling, we are continuing to focus on Year 5 key words and using the Sounds Write lessons to develop our spelling strategies.

In handwriting, we will continue to practice joining our letters and applying these skills in our everyday writing. We will be using the EverydayRULE kit to support this.

In reading, we are focusing on the Civil Rights Movement in America. Within this unit of work, the children will learn all about the lives of three prominent figures from Black History: Rosa Parks, Sarah Breedlove and Oprah Winfrey. By the end of the unit the children will be having a debate to answer our BIQ: Who had the biggest impact on the Civil Rights movement in America?

As mathematicians, we will be learning about the inverse operation, multistep problems, multiples, factors, prime numbers, square numbers, division and fractions. We will develop our fluency through bar models.

In computing, we are focusing on E-Safety and in particular looking at online bullying. This will provide the children with ways to identify online bullying and how this could be prevented.

In computing we are looking at computer systems and how info Understanding computer systems and how information is transferred between systems and devices. They will input, output, and process in a variety of different real-world systems.

In design and technology, we are looking at building bridges, different types of bridges and how to strengthen bridges. We will design, make and evaluate our own bridges.

As scientists, we will be investigating and learning all about Earth and Space. We will be focusing on what is meant by the Universe, how it was formed and what makes up our Solar System. We will also be looking at the differences between natural and artificial satellites.

In PSHE, we will be focusing Celebrating Differences. We will be discussing topics such types of bullying, strategies to help ourselves and others if involved with bullying and why discriminatory behavior is unkind. We will continue to learn about protected characteristics.
