## Welcome to Spring 2 in Year 5 Here is a brief summary of what will we be learning this term

As writers, we will be learning about settings through our portal story Clock Close. In grammar, we will be recapping and learning about: Subordinating clauses, prepositions, parenthesis, hyphens and figurative language. In spelling, we are continuing to focus on Year 5 key words and using the Sounds Write lessons to develop our spelling strategies. In handwriting, we will continue to practice joining our letters and applying these skills in our everyday writing.

In reading, we are focusing on the novels Black Beauty by Anna Sewell and War Horse by Michael Morpurgo. We will be discussing and exploring the themes present in each story, as well as making comparisons between the two.

Our Big Investigative Question is:

What is similar and what is different about the opening of Black Beauty compared to the opening of War Horse?

As mathematicians, we will be continuing to learn about Fractions in different contexts, before moving onto Decimals and Percentages.

In PE, we are continuing to work from Real PE. We will be focusing on the Creative Cog and challenging ourselves by changing activities to express our own ideas.

In Modern Foreign Languages, the children will be retrieving some of their learning from last term, alongside learning some new common everyday words and phrases.

As scientists, we will be learning about properties and changes in materials.

In PSHCE, we will be focusing on the topic Healthy Me. The children will be learning the importance of having a healthy body and mind. They will also learn how to give basic emergency aid, including the recovery position.


In RE, we will be learning about Judaism and looking to answer the question: How is Christianity expressed through the arts?'
